



Year 4 Camp - Kianinny 2018

Dear Parents and Carers

Our Year 4 students will be attending Kianinny Camp in NSW to participate in an outdoor education program from **Monday 26 March to Wednesday 28 March 2018**. The camp is located on the Tathra Road, near Tathra in NSW. The aim of the camp is to develop confidence, cooperation and teamwork. During the camp students will be involved in a number of group problem solving situations and personal challenges.

We will travel by bus to and from Kianinny. The bus will leave school at **8.30am** on Monday and will return by approximately **4:00pm** on Wednesday. The cost of the camp is \$270 per student. This amount covers return bus travel, accommodation and all meals while at camp, as well as the cost involved in the activities.

Payment needs to be made and all forms returned to the school by Friday, 16 March 2018.

Accommodation is in comfortable cabins with bunks. While the catering staff is happy to accommodate students who have special diets for health or religious reasons, they are unable to cater for likes and dislikes. If your child requires a special diet, e.g. lactose intolerant or vegetarian, please provide details on the relevant attached form.

Attached are the Payment Advice form, Camp Agreements (both Student and Kianinny), Dietary Requirements and Emergency Contact Information, Kianinny Medical Consent Form and the Clothing and Requirements List. **Please note students will be involved in a canoe activity in shallow water (life jackets are provided and are compulsory).**

Please be aware that as costs are divided by the number of students who have indicated they are attending the camp, no refunds are available. The school has an Equity Fund which may be accessed in circumstances of financial hardship. Therefore, if you anticipate any difficulty in meeting the cost of the camp please contact Mr Gray.
