Dear Parent/Guardian,

Aranda Primary School students in years 5 and 6 are participating in the St John Ambulance (ACT) First Aid in Schools Program. This presentation is designed to give your child confidence in, and knowledge of, life saving skills. Year 5 students will cover the following topics:

- What first aid is
- Seeking Assistance
- Introduction to the DRSABCD Action Plan
- Checking for Danger
- Response check - conscious/unconscious patients
- How to Send for Help (including calling 000)
- How to clear and open an Airway
- How to check for Breathing
- Unconscious, breathing patients (including recovery position)
- CPR demonstration
- Major Bleeding Treatment (including bandaging)
- Nose Bleeds
- Burns Treatment

The program will take place on the 7th to 8th August and will be held at Aranda Primary School. There is no cost involved. St John ACT funds the program through the sale of first aid kits and courses.
