



Year 4 Camp – Kianinny 2019

Dear Parents/Carers

Our Year 4 students will be attending a camp at Kianinny in the ACT to participate in an outdoor education program from **Monday, 25 March to Wednesday, 27 March 2019**. The camp is located 246 Tathra Road, Tathra, NSW. The aim of the camp is to develop confidence, cooperation and teamwork. During the camp students will be involved in a number of group problem solving situations and personal challenges. These activities may include mini golf, low ropes, archery, sensory walk, flying fox, canoeing, climbing and team sports.

We will travel by bus to and from Kianinny. The bus will leave school at **8.30am** on Monday and will return by approximately **4.30pm** on Wednesday. The cost of the camp is \$280 per student. This amount covers return bus travel, accommodation and all meals, as well as the cost involved in the activities.

Payment needs to be made and all forms returned to the school by Friday, 8 March 2019.

Accommodation is in cabins with bunks. While the catering staff are happy to accommodate students who have special diets for health or religious reasons, they are unable to cater for likes and dislikes. If your child requires a special diet e.g. lactose intolerant or vegetarian, please provide details on the relevant attached form.

Attached are the Payment Advice form, Camp Agreements, Dietary Requirements, Emergency Contact Information and Clothing and Requirements List.

Please be aware that as costs are divided by the number of students who have indicated they are attending the camp, no refunds are available. The school has an Equity Fund which may be accessed in circumstances of financial hardship. Therefore, if you anticipate any difficulty in meeting the cost of the camp please contact Mr Gray.
