

The ACT Government has appointed an expert panel to conduct an <u>inquiry into</u> <u>literacy and numeracy in ACT public schools</u>. The panel is taking submissions from the public until Wednesday 14 February. Please follow this link for more information.

New mobile phone policy for all ACT public schools starts this term:

Dear parents and carers,

You are reminded that the new Personal Use of Communication Devices in ACT Public Schools Policy will commence from the beginning of term 1, 2024.

For students at Aranda Primary School this means:

- Students in years P-10 at ACT public schools may not use or access personal communications devices at school, including recess and lunch, or during school authorised events.
- · For year 11 and 12 students, mobile phones and other personal communications devices must be silenced and put away during class time.

Special considerations and exemptions: Exemptions can be requested if a student needs their device/assistive technology:

- · to manage or monitor a medical condition
- · to help meet caring or family responsibilities
- to support adjustments for students with disability as part of an agreed individual learning plan.

If you would like to apply for an exemption please speak with our front office. A transition period up to the end of term 1, 2024 is in place for families working through the exemption process.
